S.R.P. EDWARDS & CO. LTD - CONDITIONS PRECEDENT, STREAMER

1. In adverse weather conditions where surveying has to be suspended, and weather reports indicate in a deterioration in conditions, the equipment streamed is recovered completely.

Operations may be suspended without recovering equipment provided that the weather forecast indicates that conditions will not deteriorate by much more than one Beaufort Scale and will start to improve within twenty four hours.

2. All buoys or survey equipment markers be marked by colour and fluorescent paint and/or strobe light (for night streaming).
3. Location device/transponder is attached to underwater equipment to aid recovery where applicable.
4. Guard boats, fitted with VHF radios, flares and Aldis lamps to be provided when streamer length exceeds 1.5km, in the North Sea OR other congested waters, or during multiple streamer operations.
5. Where shooting or turns are to take place in less than 30 metres of water, a guard boat fitted with side scan sonar is to carry out a route survey of the vessel's and streamers' track.
 - a. Operations in water depths of less than 20m are excluded without prior consultation with underwriters and underwriter's surveyor.
 - b. During multiple streamer operations, in the event of a single engine failure the Assured will immediately:
 - a. Reduce speed
 - b. Cease Shooting
 - c. Recover armoured sections of the streamerIn the event that actions a, b, c do not significantly reduce the engine load, full recovery is to be effected.
